

Dr. Hinrich Mählmann is the new president of the German Aluminium Association (GDA)

Düsseldorf, 9 September 2015 – Dr. Hinrich Mählmann (59) is the new president of the German Aluminium Association (GDA), Düsseldorf. He was elected in the General Assembly of the GDA on 09 September 2015 in Dusseldorf and thus succeeds Heinz-Peter Schlüter (65), who had held this function since September 2013. As Vice President of the Association the GDA General Assembly chose Kjetil Ebbesberg (44) of Hydro Aluminium Rolled Products GmbH; he is also executive vice president of the group management of Norsk Hydro ASA.

Dr. Hinrich Mählmann thanked his predecessor Heinz-Peter Schlüter, owner and chairman of TRIMET aluminum SE, Essen, for his work in his two-year presidency term.
